Job Overview

The Families Branching Out Child Care Worker is responsible to assist with the planning, implementing and delivery of a family resource program for families and children under 6 years of age within the Early Years Department.

The successful candidate will be able to:

- Work with a team to plan and implement a quality program for children (multi-age group from newborn to 5 years old), maintain healthy relationships and communicate effectively and respectfully with children, families and colleagues.
- Maintain a safe, inclusive, welcoming environment for all program participants
- Ensure the safety of the participants at all times by supervising and monitoring program activities.
- Share general maintenance responsibilities with other staff and volunteers (setting up/cleaning up, washing toys, equipment etc.)
- Participate in ongoing professional development
